## ANNOUNCEMENT AND CALL FOR PAPERS

The Organizing Committee is pleased to announce that The Tenth International Symposium on Dynamic Games and Applications will take place from Monday, July 8, to Thursday, July 11, 2002, in Saint-Petersburg State University, Saint Petersburg, Russia.

The International Symposium on Dynamic Games and Applications is a biennial professional event. The first one was held in 1984 in Haifa, Israel. It was followed by meetings in Williamsburg, USA (1986), Antibes, France (1988), Espoo, Finland (1990), Grimentz, Switzerland (1992), St. Jovite, Canada (1994) Kanagawa, Japan (1996), Maastricht, The Netherlands (1998), Adelaide, South Australia (2000). The tenth symposium is the first one to be held in Russia.

Papers and extended abstracts are required in electronic format as `<surname>.tex + <surname>.dvi + <surname>.ps` We are able to offer to you and kindly recommend to use the ISDG2002 document class for preparing the papers or abstracts. All accepted papers or extended abstracts will be published in Proceedings volumes. In addition revised papers would be published in "Annals of the Society of Dynamic Games" and "International Game Theory Review".
